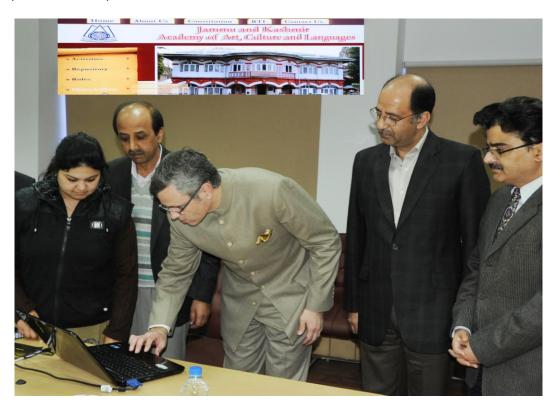
4 'Comprehensive view of activities, repository'

He said designing and hosting of a content-wise rich official website of the Academy on a secured portal was imperative for which the National Informatics Centre was approached. The designer and host of the earlier website,www.jkculture.com,has been directed to de-activate and pull off the site from the Internet immediately.
