Translation Award

- 1. The Jammu and Kashmir Academy of Art, Culture and Languages invites entries from the interested authors for the *Translation Award* 2011 carrying a cash prize of Rs 25, 000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand) for one book only in each of the languages mentioned in Schedule VI of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir.
- 2. The book must be a full unabridged and readable translation of the original work which must be a work in any of the languages viz; Urdu, Hindi, Kashmiri, Dogri, Punjabi, Ladakhi, Pahari, Dardi and Gojri besides English;
- 3. Translation of parts of an ancient or medieval classic will be eligible for the award;
- 4. A posthumous publication shall be eligible for the Award only if the translator has died within five years period from the year of award.
- 5. A book jointly published by two persons shall be eligible for the award. In the event this work wins the award the award amount shall be equally divided between the translators;
- 6. The translated work must be published during the preceding three years from the year of award i.e., 1st January 2008 to 31st December 2010 and translated by a State Subject or by person settled in the State as:-
- i. employee of the Government, a firm or the like or
- ii. engaged in business, trade or the like.
- 7. The value of the prize in each language shall be Rs 25000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only);
- 8. A translated book, which has not been recommended for the Award once, shall be entertained for re-consideration only if the author deposits a review fee of Rs 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand) only, non refundable, with the Academy in advance. However a book not recommended even for the second time shall not be entertained next time.

- 9. No prize shall be awarded if the majority of adjudicators in a particular language feel that no book has the merit to deserve the Award.
- 10. Any book which does not have the date of publication printed on the inner title cover shall not be entertained.
- 11. The books shall be initially scrutinized departmentally for short listing.
- 12. The minimum number of pages required in poetry are 80 and in prose 100 in 18x22x8 size.
- 13. The books once received for the award will not be returned and the Author's shall have no claim whatsoever over them.
- 14. Three adjudicators appointed in each language shall rate the books on a scale of one hundred depending on the quality of the book. However, if the adjudicators feel that there are more than one book/s which merit the award, they can put the same in 'YES' category in order of priority indicated by the marks allotted therein.
- 15. Only those books shall be entertained for the competition, which are written in the approved script of that language.
- In case of a dispute, the decision of the Central Committee /President of the Academy shall be final and not open to any question.
- 17. Authors would be required to submit four copies of books for the competition..
- 18. The last date of submitting translated works for the award shall be 31st of January, 2013.
